

Greetings Shalom Club movie lovers

On December 25, 2017, let's go see an early showing of "Star Wars, The Last Jedi" at Harkins Estrella Falls.

Because the recliner seats (100% in all screen rooms, excluding handicapped) can be reserved in advance, each member and their guests who want to see this together should either go to the theater or go online early on Wednesday, December 20th to buy a reserved seat for the December 25th showing that is at 11 a.m., or closest to 11 a.m. (before or after). The December 25th movie timetable may not be available at this theater prior to 12/20.

Stu Zatkow and his two adult sons will try to see it on the Cine Capri screen, if Star Wars is on this screen within 1 hour before or after 11 a.m.- a few dollars more but there are many more seats and it is one of, if not the, largest screen in the U.S. All are welcome to join Stu there

Please RSVP at the Shalom Club website to let other members know you'll be there. If you select seats in rows D, E, F or G, it's likely you'll be sitting next to a fellow member. Please make your own arrangements to sit together and to buy tickets as it would be impractical for any one person to reserve seats and collect payments.

Dinner is a separate event. The RSVP is only for the movie.

We think that any showing that begins past noon will sell out so we think there's a better chance for PCSC members to reserve seats closer to 11 a.m. The parking lot was overflowing the past two years on Christmas Day after 2 pm, and there's no reason to think this year would be different. Carpooling is recommended.

(The film will be widely released on 12/15, so hopefully many will have already seen it by 12/25)
